
## “Awakening”

Awakening is the title we have given to the visit of the Methodist Modern Art Collection to the Isle of Man between May 12th and June 10th. Don't be put off by the word modern. Some have asked if that means that all the art works are 'abstract' but modern in this sense simply means not ancient. This collection, not purchased by but gifted to the Methodist Church, 02-2018 is the most significant collection of Christian artwork outside of the Vatican. The kind of artwork that you might travel many miles to see will be on our doorstep.

This is a great mission opportunity as it has been timed deliberately to coincide with TT when we will be joined on the island by many visitors from all over the world. This is a joint endeavour with the other churches on the island and we need folk from all the churches to join in with stewarding the exhibition in its four venues. Please take every chance you can to engage with the exhibition during the Lent courses which are being laid on and once the exhibition is here. Whether or not art is your thing you will be challenged and inspired by many of the images. And they are brilliant opportunities for sparking off a conversation with folks who may not otherwise come into our churches.
