Have you ever noticed how sometimes people ask questions, not because they want to know the answer but, because they want to trip up the person they are questioning

Listen to the Today programme any morning and you will find perfect examples of people being backed into a corner where they end up saying something they never intended to, or something that others can misconstrue.

Backed into a corner Jesus reminds them of what really matters. You can have all the rules you like but what matters most is your love for God which results in your love for all God's people. As the passage from Romans reminds us "love is the fulfilment of the law."
