Church modernization project as@ 23rd February 2023

Since the F & P meeting in November, the level survey has been completed by Phil Manning (Land Survey Services). Mike Shute, the structural engineer has made recommendations regarding the proposed new floor and has asked for a trial hole to be dug outside and for the make up of the plinths inside to be investigated.

Our architect is hoping to submit the building regulations application shortly. Planning permission will be required for the air source heat pump.

A condition of the planning approval is the renovation of the stained glass windows. The restoration work by Robert Bullock is ongoing. The overall cost is estimated at £14,369.00 A pledge of 2K has been received towards the cost. An application has been submitted for additional financial support from Culture Vannin.

Sulby MC now has a Pay Pal account and a QR code which can be found on the Methodist Church in the Isle of Man website –follow the 'chapels' drop down menu to find Sulby. We submit amendments about our events and services usually on an annual basis as the life of the church regularly changes.

Rev Janet has authorized the press release regarding the project.

In the mean time we continue with community events, routine and special services. Christmas Eve numbers were back up to 150 – not as high as pre Covid, but getting there.
